# Measuring

We offer a complete measuring service; however, should you wish to take measurements, this guidance may be helpful.

Always ensure you measure where you would like the window to be covered.


## Blinds

Measure either inside or outside the window recess.

## Curtains

For an initial estimate, measure the drop from ceiling to floor.

For width, measure beyond the window on each side (approximately 15-25cm) to allow light to enter and for an elegant stack-back.

# Our Workroom

## Measuring

Every project begins with measurement, considering both proportion and placement. Blinds are measured inside or outside the recess, while curtains are initially measured from ceiling to floor.

## Fabrics & Details

If you've selected a fabric, we'll need the fabric house, name, code, width and vertical repeat. If not, estimates are based on a standard plain or sheer fabric. Trims and borders can be added, with guidance on placement. We can supply fabrics or work with your own, and arrange samples as required.

## Estimating

Estimates are shaped by the information you provide. Window photographs are particularly helpful, allowing us to anticipate any practical considerations. Specifications may evolve as the design is refined.

## Ordering & Production

Once confirmed, a deposit is taken and a Project Manager assigned. A check-measure follows, after which we recommend finalising quantities. Lead times are typically 8-12 weeks.

## Fitting

We'll confirm an approximate fitting time ahead of installation. After fitting, your Project Manager will follow up to ensure everything meets expectations before the final invoice.



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
